

Items required to board with Stepp Stables:

- <u>Current Vaccination Records</u>: We require Flu/Rhino, EE/WE/Tetanus, West Nile and Rabies. Strangles is not required, but strongly reccomended.
- <u>Current Coggins and Health Certification</u>: We require that all incoming horses have a current negative coggins and a current health certificate issued no more than 2 weeks prior to your move in date.
- <u>Current Worming</u>: We require that you bring in the box that shows the
 type of wormer, expiration date and administered date. The label of your
 daily feed through or a current negative fecal test will also be accepted. A
 dewormer must be given to any incoming horse when it arrives in
 quarantine.
- <u>Proof of Insurance</u>: We require you to have comprehensive public liability insurance on your horse. The minimum liability requirement is \$10,000 bodily injury and\$5,000 property damage. Insurance policies must clearly indicate that the coverage applies to the horse listed on your Agreement for Boarding of Privately Owned Horses and maintained away from your personal residence.
- <u>Current Agreement:</u> We require all boarders to have a current Boarding
 Agreement for each horse boarded at Stepp Stables. Each Agreement must
 be signed by both the Boarder and Stables Manager. Boarding agreements
 shall be renewed at the beginning of each year.
- Quarantine: Horses coming from in the state of California must be in quarantine for a FULL 10 days. Out of state a FULL 14 days. If horses arrive before noon, quarantine will start that day. If horses arrive after noon, quarantine will start the next day. Boarding fees will start the day the horses arrive regardless if before or after noon.

*You are required to have all of these before your move in date. If you are unable to provide the above before your move in date, other arrangements may be made with Stables Management to provide the above no later than the end of your quarantine period. If proof of all items above is not received, horse must be removed from property and all monies paid in advance will be retained by MCCS.
