Reservation Process

Venue Hold: Complimentary two-week room hold placed for requested date

Contract & Deposit: Signed Contract and deposit submitted to PVEC

Final Payment: Final payment is due to the PVEC two weeks prior to the start of your event

Base Access List: Base Access list is due to the PVEC 20 days prior to the start of your event

Event Booking Process

Client contacts PVEC.

PVEC collects Event details.

PVEC places Venue on hold

PVEC provides Client with the Authorized Vendor List.

3

Client contacts the vendor(s) they wish to work with for their Event.

4

PVEC collects final revenue payment two weeks prior to Event date.

5

Day of Event:
PVEC will support staffing for Venue

Indirect Caterer will manage and support food and beverage requirements

Gate Procedures

All guests without military identification must be submitted for base access approval. Required information (First Name, Last Name, Date of Birth, Driver's License Number, and issuing State) must be provided on the designated spreadsheet and submitted to the PVEC Team no later than 20 business days prior to the event. Failure to meet this deadline may result in guests or vendors being denied entry. The base access spreadsheet must include all attendees except Active Military, DoD personnel, Retired Military, and minors without a driver's license.

The PVEC Team will confirm acceptable forms of identification for base access.

Directions

Main Gate (located off Highway Interstate 5)

North on I-5

Take exit 54B toward Camp Pendleton
Drive to the Main Gate and enter the Base
After passing through the Main Gate, merge right to Wire Mountain Road, stay in the left lane
At the traffic light, turn left onto Wire Mountain Road
At the stop sign, turn left onto San Jacinto Road
PVEC is on the left side of the roundabout

South on I-5

Take exit 54C onto Harbor Drive
At the light, turn left onto Harbor Drive
Drive to the Main Gate and enter the Base
After passing through the Main Gate, merge right to Wire Mountain Road, stay in the left lane
At the traffic light, turn left onto Wire Mountain Road
At the stop sign, turn left onto San Jacinto Road
PVEC is on the left side of the roundabout

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can I bring in my own food?

No, due to Naval Preventative Medicine order P-5010 and Marine Corps Order P1700.30, the PVEC does not allow any food to be brought in except for Ceremonial Cake, Cupcakes, or Candy Bars. However, PVEC has an Authorized Catering Vendor list that you can choose from for your event.

2. When do I need to end my event?

All events must end at midnight.

3. Can I bring Candles?

Yes, they must be enclosed in a glass vase or votive.

4. What are the capabilities of the Audiovisual System?

Please see the PVEC Catering Department for further information.

5. Do the rooms have dance floors?

PVEC has two portable dance floors for rent, and the Del Mar room has a built-in dance floor.

6. What is the deadline for payment and final guest count?

a 50% deposit of your room fee agreement and signed contract are due within two (2) weeks of reserving the date and space. Full payment and guest count are due seven (7) days prior to your event.

7. What décor do you not allow?

Please do not bring confetti, glitter, bubbles, fake flower petals, paper lanterns, and anything that is affixed to walls, floors, ceilings, chairs, tables, and chandeliers either with glue or tape. The Client and/or Sponsor is held responsible for all damages and replacement of damaged item or piece.

8. Can I store my wedding/ceremonial cake in your refrigerator?

Unfortunately, due to health codes, we are unable to store your cake.

9. Do you have wireless internet in the rooms?

All Rooms have access; however, Clients and/or Vendors should plan to bring their own hot spot.

10. How do my guests get on base?

All guests without military identification must be submitted for base access approval. Required information (First Name, Last Name, Date of Birth, Driver's License Number, and issuing State) must be provided on the designated spreadsheet and submitted to the PVEC Team no later than 15 business days prior to the event.
